

DIRT BIKE RIDERS OF SAN ANTONIO MEMBER POLICIES 2013

- 1. ZARS RANCH is for "MEMBERS ONLY". Members MAY NOT lend, loan, duplicate or give property keys or permission to ride to other members or non-members. A member who allows this to happen will lose their membership for that calendar year.
- 2. Each member will be responsible for completing 16 work hours per year. There are several ways of fulfilling this obligation. Some examples would be attending scheduled work days at a club property, assisting during a club-sponsored event or participating in other club activities. <u>Reimbursement of funds to new members will be issued upon completion of 16 work hours. Partial reimbursements will not be issued. Reimbursements will be made within the calendar year. Incomplete work hours the following year will result in the member paying the full deposit and membership fees to resign.</u>
- 3. Due to safety concerns, riding alone is prohibited. The individual you are riding with must also be a current member of DBSA.
- 4. All new members will be required to attend a new rider orientation at the DBSA riding area (s). Additionally, a new member must attend a monthly member's meeting to receive their key to the property.
- 5. No hunting or fishing of any kind is allowed on the property.
- 6. No discharging of firearms, using bows and arrows or fireworks will be permitted on the property. If a member is caught using any of these items, the member may be prosecuted or banned from DBSA.
- 7. Open camp fires are allowed in designated areas only.
- 8. No chasing or tormenting the livestock or other animals on the property will be permitted. The landowner has several cows on Zars Ranch that DBSA shares this space with. Wildlife and cattle have the right of way.
- 9. Members are responsible for ensuring the gate is LOCKED upon ENTRY and EXIT of the property and for signing in/out at the mailbox.
- 10. ALL members are responsible for picking up and removing trash on the property. DBSA does not own Zars Ranch; we are only guests there. The owner of this property <u>insists</u> that the property be kept trash free and will revoke the use of this property if this policy is not followed.
- 11. Members are responsible for all actions of themselves, their family members and guests (if applicable).
- 12. Parking is allowed in designated areas only.
- 13. The **ONLY** vehicles allowed in the riding area are **MOTORCYCLES** and **QUADS**. No pickups, bicycles, cars, dune buggies, etc.
- 14. <u>Members must have a copy of their membership application in their vehicle and key in their possession while on the property (keys may be maintained on your person or in your vehicle).</u> Refusal to comply may result in being asked to leave the property and having your membership reviewed by the board.
- 15. All junior riders, 14 and under, must NOT be left unaccompanied at any time. This will include all parking and riding areas.
- 16. Slower riders MUST keep to the right of the trails to allow passing.
- 17. Trails marked with ribbon are one way only. **Keep the ribbon to your right** while riding them. Trails not marked by ribbon are bi-directional. Ride with caution.
- 18. All pets must be on a leash at all times.
- 19. No riding on club property on days when special events or workdays are scheduled.
- 20. DBSA will provide portable toilets ("porta potties") at the property. These are located in the camp area.
- 21. ALL members WILL comply with the 5-mph speed limit in the pit and camping area. This will include all motorized vehicles. Additionally, "burn-outs", wheelies or roosting in this area will be prohibited. This is a "CAUTION AREA"
- 22. Cutting and removing firewood from the property is prohibited.
- 23. Helmets must be worn at all times while operating any approved off-road vehicle on the property.
- 24. Guest riders must complete a guest rider form and submit the guest day fee before riding. Fees are \$20 for adults, \$10 for youth 15 and under with a family maximum of \$40. ABSOLUTELY NO GUEST RIDERS without a valid guest pass.
