Adolph Emil Nesloney, Jr., 83, of San Antonio, Texas passed away peacefully on July 2, 2022.

Dolph, as he was known to most, was born Nov. 28, 1938 in Corpus Christi to Emma Korczynski and Adolph Nesloney. He attended Roy Miller High School and earned a BA in business administration from St. Mary's University in 1963. Following college, Dolph served in the United States Marine Corps Reserves for several years and worked at Texaco as a sales supervisor for 10 years. Dolph began fixing cars when he was in high school, a job that eventually led to him starting his own shop in 1973. He developed and managed Nesloney Auto Repair until selling it to Eric Nesloney when he retired. This solid family business served the Dellview area for 49 years. Dolph was a founding member of the Dirt Bike Club of San Antonio and served as the treasurer for over 40 years. He was a member of the San Antonio Garage Association, the Texas Independent Automotive Association, and the Nimrod Gun and Rifle Club. Dolph was preceded in death by his parents and his son, Eric Nesloney. He is survived by his wife, Jeri Nesloney; his children, Greg Nesloney, Carey Horchler, Jennifer Nesloney (with Carolyn Jeter); daughter-in-law, Courtney Nesloney, son-in-law, Steve Horchler; step-daughter, Jennifer White; 7 grandchildren, 4 step-grandchildren, and 1 great grandchild; his sister, Sarilyn Uroda; his cousin, George Schroeder, and many extended family members and friends who loved him.
